I, Danielle Cardozo, ᑭᐱᑭᐱᐱ Land Law Voting Officer for ᑭᐱᑭᐱᐱ in the Province of British Columbia, DO SOLEMNLY DECLARE THAT:

1. I was present at ᑭᐱᑭᐱᐱ on the 30th day of June, 2015 when Eligible Voters of ᑭᐱᑭᐱᐱ voted concerning approval of the ᑭᐱᑭᐱᐱ Matrimonial Real Property Law in accordance with the *St. Mary's Indian Band Land Code*.
2. A true copy of the Notice of Vote is attached as Exhibit "1" to this Declaration.
3. In accordance with Section 11.3 of the *St. Mary's Indian Band Land Code* the Notice of Vote was posted at least 10 days prior to the Voting Day.
4. In accordance with the *St. Mary's Indian Band Land Code*, a copy of the Notice of Vote, and a copy of the ᑭᐱᑭᐱᐱ Matrimonial Real Property Law was sent to each person on the Eligible Voter's list at his or her last known address.
5. The voting procedure, including the handling of mail-in ballots and the counting of results, was conducted in substantially the same manner as set out in Sections 168 to 177, both inclusive, of the *St. Mary's Indian Band Custom Election Regulations*.
6. The names of 284 Eligible Voters appeared on the List of Voters.
7. The number of Eligible Voters who cast their Vote was 67.
8. The number of Eligible Voters who constituted a Majority was 34.
9. The number of Eligible Voters who constituted the minimum 10% required for a quorum of Eligible Voters under Section 13.3 of the *St. Mary's Indian Band Land Code* was 29.
10. The results of the Land Law Vote are as follows:
 - (a) 67 ballots were cast in the Land Law Vote;

(b) 0 ballots were spoiled;

(c) 0 ballots were rejected;

(d) 44 ballots were marked "YES" for the Ballot Question; and

(e) 23 ballots were marked "NO" for the Ballot Question.


10. The *Ṛaḡam Matrimonial Real Property Law* was **approved** by Ṛaḡam Eligible Voters.

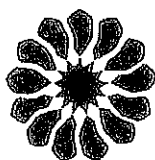



Voting will take place on **June 30th from 10:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.** local time at:


