Summary of the ?aqam Community Land Use Plan:

The ?aqam Community Land Use Plan provides ?aqam with guidance to regulate on-reserve land under Land Code, while planning for community needs and sustainable resource use. The ?aqam Community Land Use Plan sets forth the vision for how ka ?amaknała (our lands) will be used through a series of visual maps along with a set of Policies to ensure the vision is implemented.

If an Eligible Voter wishes to vote by mail-in ballot and has not received voting documents by February 1, 2016, please contact the ʔaqam Lands Officer so that the necessary documents can be supplied to you.

If an Eligible Voter wishes to vote by phone-in ballot, please phone 250-426-5717 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on February 25, 2016. **Collect calls will be accepted for Voters phoning long-distance**.

Voting from Outside Canada:

If you live outside Canada you are encouraged to vote by phone-in ballot to ensure that your vote is received by the closing of polls. Mail-in ballots that are not received by the closing of polls will not be counted in the vote.
